Your privacy is important to Bring It On Limited. We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of those we deal with. This privacy statement sets out how we will treat your personal information.

Personal Data Collection

Bring It On Limited may collect, store, and use the following kinds of personal information:

- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of registering with us or for taking part in Bring It On events.
- Information relating to any transactions carried out between you and us on or in relation to our website.
- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of subscribing to our website services, email notifications or newsletters.
- Information about your computer and about your visits to and use of our website (which may include your IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, referral source, entry page, exit page, length of visit, number of page views, route taken through this website, and similar information).
- Any other information that you choose to send to us.

Using Personal Data

Personal data held about you will be used in accordance with the following policies:

- Data held and processed by the Company will only be used for purposes associated with the delivery of its charitable objectives and in particular the delivery of the Bring It On Exhibition and any associated events, including 'online' activities.
- Data will never be passed to third parties for commercial gain.
- Data will only be passed to third parties where this is necessary to fulfil the Company's legal obligations, for the delivery of the Company's Charitable Objectives or to permit suppliers or contractors to deliver their contractual obligations to the Company. Third parties are required to use this data only for the purposes for which it is provided.
- Data will be passed to our Trustees to enable them to carry out their legal obligations. They are required to use such data only for the purpose for which it was provided and to delete it when no longer required for that purpose or when they cease to be a Trustee.

Personal information submitted to us directly or via our website will be used only for the purposes specified in this privacy statement or in relevant parts of our website.

We may use your personal data to:

- Enable your participation in Bring It On events and related services including via our website.
- Send you general non marketing communications related to the above.
- Send you email notifications which you have specifically requested.
- Send you newsletters and other marketing communications relating to our events.
- Deal with enquiries and complaints made by or about you relating to our website.
- Administer our website.
- Improve your browsing experience.

- To any person who we reasonably believe may apply to a court or other competent authority for disclosure of that personal information where, in our reasonable opinion, such court or authority would be reasonably likely to order disclosure of that personal information.

Except as provided in this privacy statement, we will not provide your information to third parties.

Your Rights

You may instruct us to provide you with any personal information we hold about you. Provision of such information will be subject to the supply of appropriate evidence of your identity.

We may withhold such personal information to the extent permitted by law.

You may instruct us not to process your personal information for marketing purposes by email at any time.
