Bring It On, The Exhibition for Future Engineers in the North East and the Tees Valley

is about to enter its sixth successful year. Live exhibitions have been run, in 2017, 2018 and 2019. In 2020 and 2021, due to the Coronavirus pandemic, we delivered Bring it On virtually.

In 2020 we produced a series of videos featuring local engineering companies and the engineers that work for them. In 2021 we broadcast a live event into schools to coincide with COP26. The content from both can be viewed on our website.

Whilst the virtual events have been highly successful, they are not a complete substitute for a live exhibition.



In 2022 we plan to revert to a live event, on October 12th and 13th at the Beacon of Light building in Sunderland. We will re-establish Bring It On as the major showcase of North East engineering for young people, keeping with the founding principles which have made Bring It On a success.

We are hoping to deliver three innovative new features in 2022:

- We will invite local Universities and Colleges to offer their final year engineering students the opportunity to visit the exhibition during the middle evening to meet exhibiting companies.
- We will invite schools to bring parents with them to experience the exhibition and hopefully inspire their children and their friends to become engineers.
- We will add a virtual element to allow the exhibition to be experienced by a wider cohort of pupils and schools and allow Headline Supporters who have a significant interaction with schools to make their own 'broadcasts' from Bring It On.

What we can do may depend on the prevailing Covid situation, but we will consult closely with the venue, schools, local authorities, exhibitors, and other interested parties and adjust our plans if necessary. The Institution of Mechanical Engineers' Covid Task Force will advise on any additional precautions or equipment that may be desirable.

As always, our objectives will be to raise the aspirations of youngsters in our region and contribute to closing the engineering skills gap by **Educating** pupils about the engineering activities taking place around them, **Inspiring** them to want to be part of it and **Informing** them about what they need to do to become so.
